

Trading setup

1. Entry Conditions

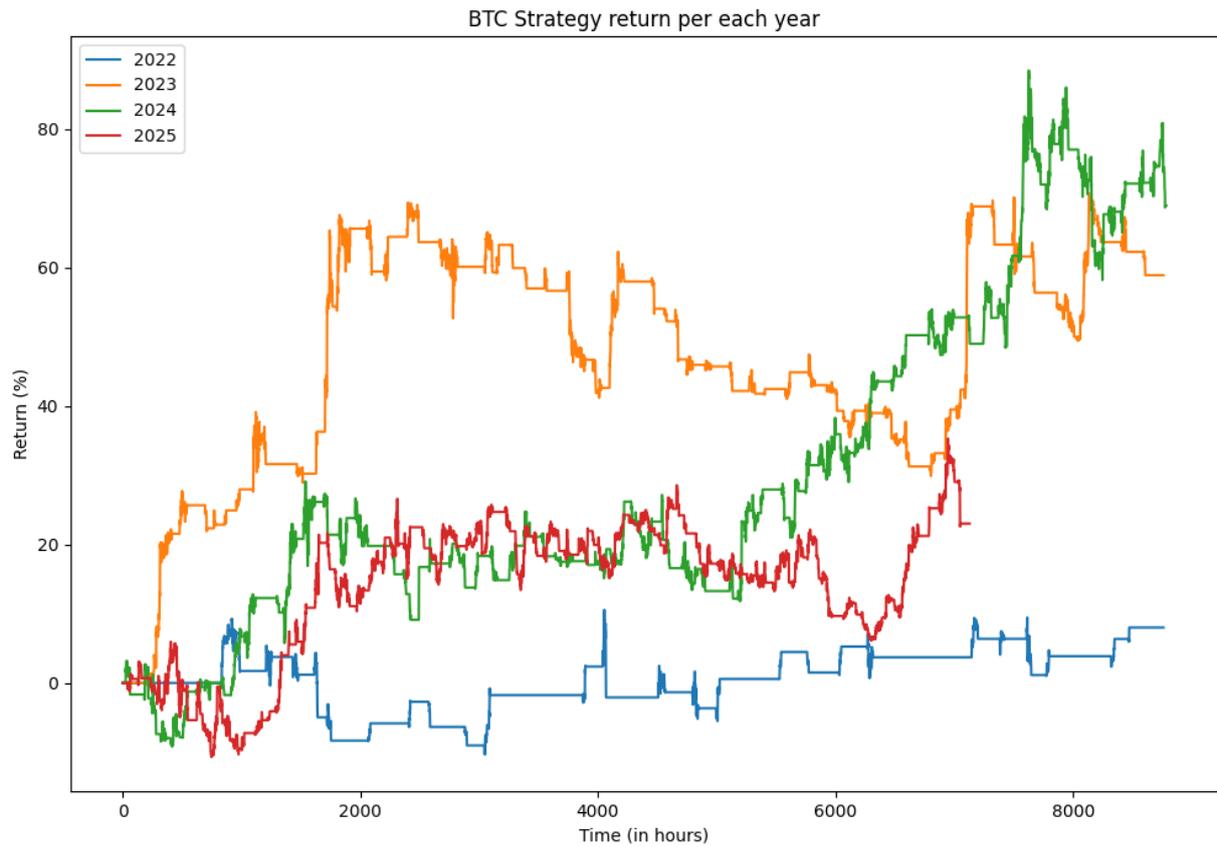
- a. The strategy opens long position when the trading signal value equals 10
- b. It opens short position when the signal value equals 1
- c. Each trade pays transaction fee on entry of 0.05% - which is average historical transaction cost on BTC perp futures
- d. Upon entry, the strategy sets the take-profit and stop-loss levels dynamically based on the ATR (Average True Range) of the past 48 hours, meaning TP/SL can vary, sometimes as tight as 2% or wider than 15%, depending on market volatility at the time of entry, and once a position is open, these TP/SL levels remain fixed until the trade is closed.

2. Exit conditions

Once a position is open, the strategy continuously checks for exit triggers. A trade can close for one of the following reasons:

- a. Take-Profit (TP): The price moves favourably by a predefined percentage based on the entry price.
- b. Stop-Loss (SL): The price moves against the position by the same predefined percentage.
- c. Signal-Based Exit
 - i. For long trades, if the signal drops to 5 or below, that's a potential exit.
 - ii. For short trades, if the signal rises to 5 or above, that's a potential exit.
 - iii. However, the strategy will only exit on a signal change if the trade is already in profit. If the trade is in loss, strategy will omit signal-based exit rules from i. and ii., and only use TP/SL exits.
- d. Time-Based Exit: If the trade has been open for 48 hours or more, it automatically closes at the current price.
